THE PROBLEM

Midwest Court was in pursuit of upgrading their dated oil-fired boiler system due to its inefficiency and increased maintenance expenses. The existing chimney would remain, so the challenge came in the large footprint of the exiting low efficient boiler system which supplied both space heating and domestic hot water. The massive project would require demolition of the existing system and installation of a new system, all while the building remained fully occupied.

THE SOLUTION

RBI's Futera XLF units provided the large BTU capacity required in a compact footprint which allowed the installation of the new system to occur alongside staged demolition of the past equipment. The building systems where kept live the entire time which was critical for the apartment building occupants.

The RBI system reduced the mechanical room to half the original size, putting valuable NYC real estate back in the hands of the owner. The Futera XLF's unique design provided the high efficiency upgrade while still maintaining the existing chimney system. With HeatNet's onboard Boiler Management system the firing sequence is optimized and the boilers have true rotation for equalized runtime. HeatNet also provided the necessary remote monitoring and trending to allow a proactive response by the mechanical team to any potential service issues before they arise.



RBI is an integral part of the Midwest Courts' central operating system. RBI's domestic water heaters assist in eliminating storage which was originally planned for during the design phase. The compact size of the Futera XLF allowed installation to occur alongside demolation keeping the building fully operational for occupants.

The Futera XLF provides large capacities in a small footprint and offers greater flexibility and ease of installation in a space-saving design that leaves more elbowroom in the mechanical room. The rugged structural steel base is designed to fit through a standard 30" doorway.
