To Whom It May Concern:

Smith Cast Iron Boiler products are fully compliant with the “Buy American” act and its provisions.

The jacket assembly, heat exchanger (cast iron), controls and complete assembly of the finished product and all of these components are of U.S. origin.

While the aforementioned items represent the majority of our product configuration, they are not the only U.S. manufactured products used in assembly of Smith Cast Iron Boilers. However they are the most significant items in terms of cost. Total overall percentage of U.S. origin materials used in the manufacturing of these units is 100% and 100% of the assembly of the product is done domestically in Boyertown, PA.

Mestek Inc., the parent company of Smith Cast Iron Boilers, is an American based corporation with total sales in excess of \$450 million. Mestek is also the parent to other domestic companies including Hydrotherm Boilers, a manufacturer of hydronic boilers and Sterling Radiator, established in 1946.
